

SEPTEMBER 11, 2023 MONTHLY MEETING

TOWN OF HARRISON

The regular monthly meeting for the Town of Harrison was held at Northland Church on Monday, September 11, 2023. Notice of the meeting was posted according to standards set by State Statutes. Chairman Dean Lashua called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M. Present at the meeting were Mike Schultz, John Phillips, Rose Troast, Carried Powell, Roger Koczac, and Fran Moen.

Mr. Koczac gave the board and update on the Rosholt School District. They have ordered a new school bus. They are painting the interior of the school back to the school colors of black and yellow. Anyone with questions concerning the school district are invited to contact Mr. Koczac.

The Clerk's minutes from the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by John Phillips and second by Mike Schultz to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was given. The beginning balance on August 1, 2023 was \$78085.77. Deposits for the month totaled \$28,891.28 and the total of checks written and automatic withdrawals totaled \$23,582.90 leaving a balance in the account on August 31, 2023 of \$83,394.15. The money market account had a beginning balance of \$87,211.29 and the interest collected was \$11.11 leaving a balance in the account of \$87,222.40. The ARPA account has a balance of \$23,969.81.
